

Add an Academic Integrity Template to your Course

A quick guide to adding a quiz and/or assignment template that requires students to acknowledge the UNLV Academic Misconduct Policy

OVERVIEW & PURPOSE

This quick guide is used to add a quiz and/or assignment template into your course. The template is designed so students must acknowledge they are complying with the UNLV Academic Misconduct Policy. Research has shown this simple acknowledgement deters incidents of cheating (see references below). There is an Assignment template and a Quiz template available in the Canvas Commons that present the Academic Integrity policy for UNLV. These templates can be used to make a new quiz or assignment (e.g. for written work or homework submissions).

STEP 1: LOGIN INTO WEBCAMPUS

Login to WebCampus (powered by Canvas) and click on your course in the **DASHBOARD**.

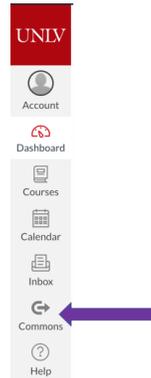

STEP 2: HOW TO IMPORT THE OE TEMPLATE(S)

Here are the steps on how to import the UNLV Academic Integrity Templates:

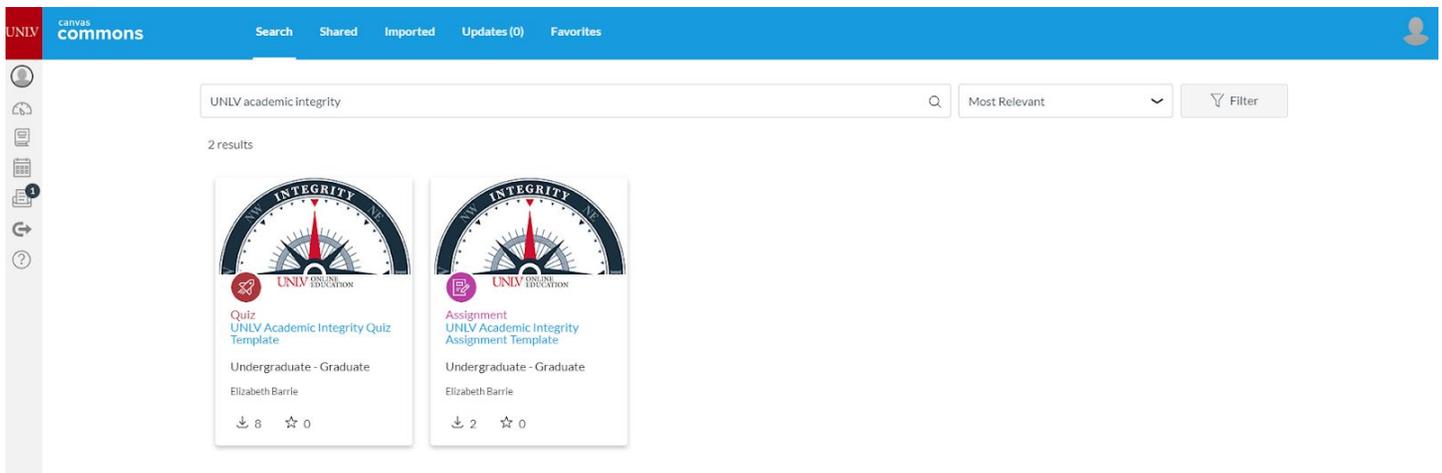
1. Open the Canvas Commons.

From your Canvas **DASHBOARD**, click on **COMMONS** in the Global Navigation column on the left side of the screen.



2. Locate the item you would like to import.

In the search bar, type **UNLV academic integrity**.



3. Open the template you are interested in using.

To open the **template**, click the title (in light blue) or use these links:

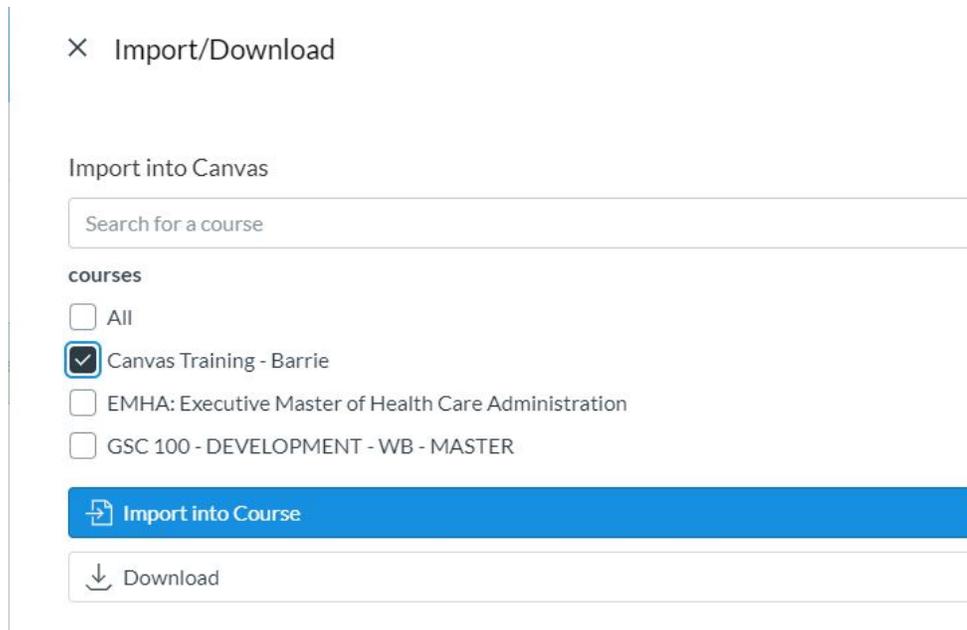
4. Import the template into your course.

Click on [Import/Download](#) on the right side of the screen.



5. Select your course.

You can import the template into all your courses or just one. After you have made your selection, click on the [Import into Course](#) button.

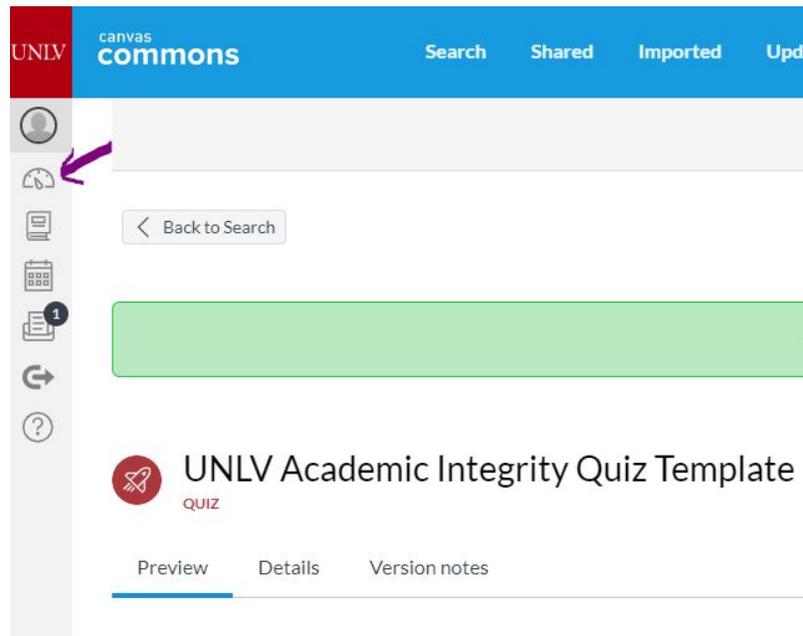


You will see a message that the import has started:

You have successfully started the import! It may take a little while to see changes in your course.

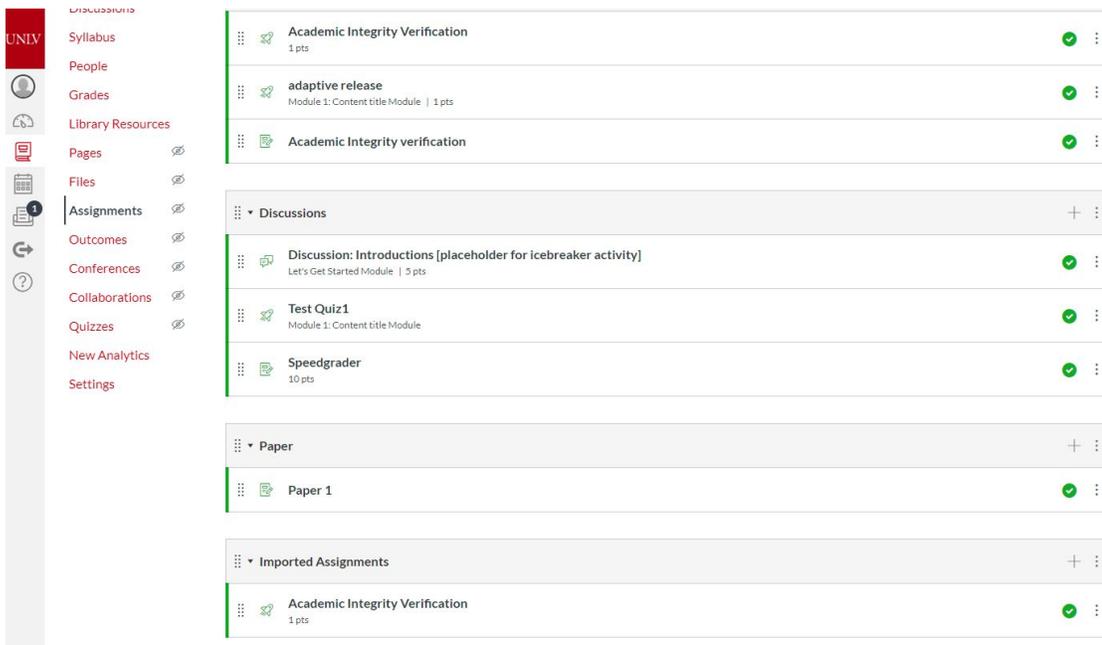
6. Go back to your course.

Click on the **DASHBOARD** icon to go to your dashboard and select the course you'll be using the template in.



STEP 3: PLACE THE TEMPLATE

Click on the **ASSIGNMENTS** area of the course and scroll down to **IMPORTED ASSIGNMENTS**.



Click on the template you imported to edit it to fit your needs. You will need to place the quiz or assignment in an area that students can access (e.g., in a module or on a stand alone page).
